
Bring In Your Used Glow Sticks!!

It is recommended that Glow Sticks be treated as Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)


Please bring in this Halloween's used Glow Sticks by 11/4 and Travell's Green Team will bring them to the local HHW drop-off.

WHAT IS BAG A LUNCH?
