During recording, we will use a green screen in order to allow you to add special effects to your segment. After recording, you will use video editing software to make your news segment using your creativity. At the end we bring all of the segments together to create a news broadcast!

Bubble Blast Gr. K-2

If you enjoy blowing and popping bubbles, then this is



the course for you! We will learn the history of bubbles while

we create bubble solutions, learn bubble recipes, make giant bubbles, and play bubble games. We will also complete many science activities revolving around water.

Movie Making Gr. 3-5 We will go through all of the steps

of making a movie. We begin with some lessons on different genres of movies as well as different mediums that can be used. We explore stop motion, animation, live action, and (computer generated image) films. After exploring the options, you will choose a genre and a medium through which they will develop their own film. You will create a storyline, storyboard and script for your movie. Once all the planning has been done, you will begin to create props, decide on costumes, scope out sets and cast actors for your movie. Now it is time to record. You will spend some time recording your films in live sets as well as on green screens. After recording has finished, you will use video editing software to add visual and sound effects to your movie as well as some other finishing touches like title screens and credits.

We will start with basic shapes like flowers, leaves, and hearts. Combine shapes to make more complex designs. Experiment with different color combinations

Rocketry Gr. 3-5

Explore how NASA and other scientists were able to build rockets that could be launched into space. In the first part of rocketry class, we will work on building paper rockets and launch them using an air launcher. We will build rockets with different types of paper to observe which ones work best and hypothesize why. In part two, we will build a balsam fin model rocket with a parachute recovery system. After building the rocket, we will paint and decorate the rocket to make it unique. We will then use a motor-based rocket system to launch our rockets about 300-800 feet in the air! **Please note parent** & child need to sign safety form and there will be an additional supply cost of \$15.

Rocks, Minerals & Gems Gr. K-2

Students will learn all about rocks, minerals, gems and other things related to the

earth. We will include rock painting, rock crafts and all sorts



of hands-on activities. We will also do panning excursions, mining activities, and grow our own crystals! Learning about the Earth and how it was made is EXCITING!
