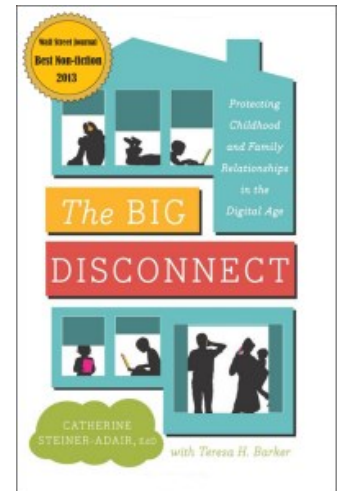


Ridgewood Public Schools
