Turn off the lights!?

The Problem

- Lights around all 9 schools are being left on unnecessarily
- Wastes money and power
 - It is about 13 cents per kwh



The Solution

- Motion sensors in hallways/gyms/necessary classrooms
- 20+ year life span



Financial Impacts

- Costs \$200 to purchase a sensor and around \$300 to install
- \$0.13 per Kilowatt Hour
- Theoretically the sensors will save at least 6 9 hours

• 1,000 excessive lights x a wattage of 60 x 6 hours per day x 300 days in a year / 1,000 to turn W to Kw x \$0.13 = \$14,040 per year
