

RESOLUTION NO. 20-113

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 246 of the Ridgewood Village Code, *Soil Removal*, an application has been made to the Planning Board of the Village of Ridgewood for the granting of a Major Soil Moving Permit. The application was filed on behalf of the Ridgewood Board of Education, for the parcel designated as Block 2312, Lot 10, also known as Orchard School; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the hearing by the Planning Board on March 17, 2020, has been delayed until a suitable date, however the Ridgewood Board of Education must schedule the work of this project this summer when school is out; and


WHEREAS, a review of the proposed Major Soil Moving Permit by the Village Police Department and the Engineering Division of the Department of Public Works notes no issues of concern and recommend to the Village Council that the Major Soil Permit be granted conditioned on the applicant's compliance with the terms of the resolution of memorialization and with the conditions established by the Village Engineer; and


WHEREAS, the Village Council will receive the recommendation of the Planning Board once a hearing has been held and also the review of the Major Soil Permit received from the Village Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Ridgewood that the Major Soil Permit, as applied for by the Ridgewood Board of Education, for the parcel designated as Block 2312, Lot 10 on the tax assessment map, also known as Orchard School, be granted, subject to compliance with the terms and conditions of the Village Planning Board Resolution when it is adopted; provided, however, that in the event that any disparity is noted among such terms and conditions, those contained within this Resolution of the Village Council shall take precedence:

1. A cash deposit, letter of credit, or performance bond, satisfactory in form and content to the Village Attorney in the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) DOLLARS shall be filed by the contractor performing the trucking with the Village in order to guaranty compliance with the recommendations of the Village Engineer.
2. The applicant shall supply a detailed trucking route for trucking to and from the premises and said route shall be subject to the approval of the Village Engineer and the Chief of Police or her designee, which approval shall be received, in writing, prior to any soil movement activity.
3. The Ridgewood Board of Education shall provide unfettered access for staff from the Engineering Division to conduct inspections and observations of the soil moving work, as well as observation of the soil movement's effects on Village streets and roads.
4. Soil trucking shall only be permitted between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 5:30 P.M., Monday through Friday. No trucks, either full or empty shall be permitted in any of the Village's designated school zones (i.e. South Monroe Street by George Washington Middle School, West Ridgewood Avenue by Ridge School, East Ridgewood Avenue by the High School, etc.) during the start of school or school dismissal.
5. No trucking will be permitted on any Village streets not identified in the approved trucking route.
6. At the site exit, the soil moving contractor shall provide for any necessary traffic control for the safe movement of trucks. Traffic control shall be provided by off-duty Village of Ridgewood Police Traffic Officers only at the sole expense of the contractor.
7. The permit proposes to move approximately 5,507 cubic yards of material.
